



The total fixed fee includes UCD tuition, orientation, and health insurance valid during the program. In late April the Bloomington bursar will send an e-mail notifying you that your statement is available for viewing through IU Bursar Pay. Your \$500 prepayment and any IUB scholarships or loans will be listed as credits there.

The IU Service fee underwrites the operation of the Office of Overseas Study.

UCD Refund Policy

The Overseas Study Fee and the provider fees are refunded on a cost-recoverable basis only. Student who withdrawal from IU programs are responsible for ALL non-recoverable costs. Your Bursar account will be assessed an additional charge to cover any/ all amounts that Overseas Study has committed or paid on your behalf and are non-recoverable at the time of withdrawal, possibly including housing and transportation.
