



The IFSA fees (OVST Provider instructional fee and OVST provider miscellaneous fee) includes academic fees, room, most meals, study trips, and medical insurance. The miscellaneous provider fee includes the non-instructional costs of the program, such as housing and health insurance. In late December the Bloomington bursar will send an e-mail notifying you that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through IU Bursar Pay. Your \$500 prepayment and any IUB scholarships or loans will be listed as credits there.

The IU Service fee underwrites the operation of the Office of Overseas Study.
