



The CIEE fee (OVST Provider instructional fee and OVST provider miscellaneous fee) includes academic fees, standard housing, two meals per day for those in a homestay (no meals are included for the apartment option), orientation, cultural activities, local excursions, and medical insurance. The miscellaneous provider fee includes the non-instructional costs of the program, such as housing (\$6,000) and health insurance (\$194). In late December, the Bloomington bursar will send an e-mail notifying you that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through *IU Bursar Pay*. Your \$500 prepayment and any IUB scholarships or loans will be listed as credits there.

The IU Service fee underwrites the operation of the IU Education Abroad office.

CIEE Refund Policy

Students who withdraw or defer their participation and notify CIEE on or more than 15 days prior to their advertised program start date will forfeit their \$500 prepayment. Students that withdraw or defer 14 days or less prior to the advertised start date will be charged 25% of the program fee.
