



The IU fees cover academic fees, Overseas Study Health Cover (OSHC), the Student Amenities Fee, and repatriation and medical emergency insurance. In late August you will be notified by the Bloomington Bursar via e-mail that your statement is available for viewing from the web through IU Bursar Pay. The \$500 prepayment and any applicable IUB financial aid will be reflected as credit.
